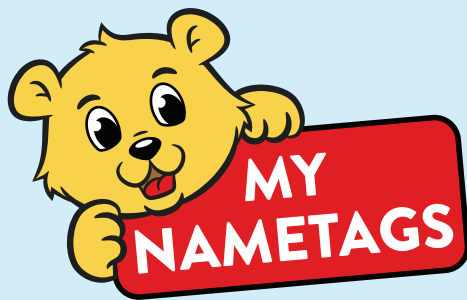

My Nametags offers a simple and uncomplicated fundraising programme.
Participate in our program by following a few simple steps.



STEP 1

Get your unique School ID

A School ID is essential for us to link an order to the correct school. It is important for the school to ensure parents are using the School ID when placing an order. The unique School ID does not expire, no need to get a new one every year!

How does it work?

To get a School ID, simply email schools@mynametags.com with the subject “School ID” including the school name, full address (including Eircode), telephone number and contact name. We will set up your School ID, and the only thing you have to do after that is to communicate the School ID number to parents.

STEP 2

How to use your School ID?

Applying to our fundraising scheme means parents will be able to order on our website using your School ID, so every order placed will be credited to your school.

OPTION 1

Web Link

When you include a link to our website on your School page, it allows parents to place orders directly with My Nametags. This link allows parents to click through and your school will automatically be credited with the order value.

How does it work?

Parents can order nametags directly from our website by entering the School ID at the checkout page. This process requires no involvement from the school and your organisation automatically receives the fundraising credit once a year.

Funds are distributed annually in January/February, with a minimum total of €40 required.

STEP 3

How to promote your School ID?

Once you have your ID, you should start promoting it. We recommend you introduce the fundraising programme to parents in different ways such as:

What to tell parents?

FAQs

How can the school get leaflets to give to parents?

Who can request a School ID?

Any staff member or PTA representative of the school or nursery can request a School ID. Please email us at schools@mynametags.com with the subject "School ID", and include the organisation name, address, telephone number and contact name.

How can we encourage parents to order?

We suggest to provide a leaflet to every parent in the induction pack, welcome pack, or their child's school bag. Additionally, we encourage you to download our poster and exhibit it prominently, such as on the School's Noticeboard.

How much is postage & packing?

Posting and packing is free of charge with My Nametags.

When will the school receive the fundraising funds?

All the commissions are paid by BACS transfer (subject to a minimum of €40) every February.

How can we get credit if a parent orders online?

If the parent clicks the link provided, the school will receive credit. If not, kindly provide parents with the School ID, which they will need to enter during the checkout/delivery process.

How soon is delivery of the Nametags?

We deliver within a week from date of receipt of your order.

Can we try out some nametags samples?

We would be happy to send you some samples, to prove the quality of My Nametags labels. Email us with the organisation name, address, phone number and contact name, and we will send you some samples.

Can the commission be paid directly to the PTA instead of the school?

We can transfer the commission either to the school/nursery or directly to the PTA. Please provide the full bank details of the account for payment.
